3.	<p>Collaboration with the 'Network for Experimental Research in Interprofessional Practice and Education' (www.neripe.org) lead by Hassan Soubhi (Guest participant)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provided history & background of NERIPE. • Concrete research project – the multisite website. • Broader than just “experimental”. • Continuum of research from pre-experimental to quasi-experimental to controlled research model. • Combination or collaboration between CIHC ResearchNet and NERIPE. • Broad approach; can attain the goals of both groups. <p>CIHC-ResearchNet Database Development and Hosting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Goals of both CIHC ResearchNet & NERIPE can be attained by one website. • Hassan has colleagues in Brazil that may collaborate; but need to develop own content due to particular local context. • Make it available to graduate students as well. <p>CIHC-ResearchNet Database Maintenance and Management:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hassan has funding to maintain & develop website for approx. 12 to 24 months. • Has registered domain name & is working on the technicalities of the content. • Some thoughts regarding what website should accomplish: research dissemination (eBooks; blogs; video/audio streaming; teleconferences); knowledge exchange for graduate students; newsletter. • Need to have some type of product(s) that will allow website to be self-sufficient. • How to monitor the site. • Ask NaHSSA to distribute invitations for volunteers; provide certificates of service for those who volunteer. • On the first page of website, explain mandate of group & website: “what is experimental” research. 	<p>Hossein to join Hassan’s meeting with his website developer on May 6 12 noon EDT. Discuss specific requirements of what the website should have. Provide developer with specific technical requirement.</p> <p>Hassan to develop Mandate & circulate to group for comments.</p>
