Rotate small groups through 3 different tables. One presenter at each table. Each table will pose 1 to 2 questions. If lots of attendees, might add a fourth table with another question. Presenter poses questions, reflects back answers from previous small group and takes notes. No need for a talk back report. No flip chart required; only notepads. Get attendees to group with people from different jurisdictions (mix them up). • 100 minute limit. Introduction 5 minutes; World Café 45 minutes (15 mins at each table); 45 minutes Presentation / Survey results; 5 minutes wrap up / Q&A.
