1	Welcome to members, Review of current agenda and previous meeting minute. Minutes approved.	
2	Update: No specific updates. CIHC-ResearchNet has been talking about the network collaboration with NaHSSA.	
3	Survey: <u>Should Survey be called a Questionnaire:</u> - Leave as Survey. - Survey looks at what is the current situation; at what is in place; data collection. - Questionnaire poses questions for respondents to respond with their thoughts and opinion. <u>Survey Question No. 7:</u> - Replace with following language: 1. How many interprofessional research projects are currently being conducted at your university? 2. Are any of these interprofessional research projects funded? 3. If yes, who is providing the funding?

	<p><u>Survey Send Out:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Send out Survey in different "waves" or phases. - Initial delivery; followed up in 2 weeks by a second delivery to non-responders; followed up in another 2 weeks by third delivery to non-responders. <p><u>Add Simple Goal of the Survey:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Describe goal of survey (i.e. envision an IP research network; currently no IP research network in place). <p><u>Set up Separate E-Mail for Survey Responders:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Could be a hotmail/gmail account. - Preferred if it could be established as an CIHC address; also link to Survey Monkey; Susan to discuss with Alix. - Should keep Survey short, simple and to the point; get data in order to move forward with next steps to establishing the IP Research Network. - Susan to revise draft Survey as discussed & circulate to group. 	
4	<p>Network Collaboration with Canadian Health Human Resources Research Network (CHHRRN)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ivy is in the process of scheduling a teleconference. - Dr. Gilbert to contact CHHRRN first and then move forward with more formal collaboration. - Let Ivy Bourgeault hold her teleconference first before scheduling our own teleconference. - Important issue for discussion is while we propose that IP collaboration is a solution to workforce issues, we have not been clear as to how it will be the solution. - In high performance teams, many people find that they shed themselves of certain responsibilities if they know others have the competency to take those responsibilities; thus, freeing up time & resources. <p>IPE Conference in January 23-25, 2011</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Need a presence at IP Ontario Conference; Hossein to contact Maria at University of Toronto. - Perhaps set up a table or poster; Hossein to discuss with Alix.
